Richard G. Stys is vice president and treasurer of Hartford HealthCare (HHC), the premiere health care network in Connecticut with 15,000 employees and \$2 billion in net revenue. The HHC system includes Hartford Hospital; The Hospital of Central Connecticut; MidState Medical Center; Windham Hospital; The Institute of Living psychiatric center; VNA HealthCare; Clinical Laboratory Partners with more than 80 locations statewide; Hartford Medical Group; MidState Medical Group; The Doctors of Central Connecticut; Central Connecticut Senior Health Services, which includes five assisted-living and skilled-nursing facilities; Eastern Rehabilitation Network; and two regional behavioral health centers, Rushford and Natchaug Hospital.

Mr. Stys' primary responsibilities are oversight and management of system investments, pensions and insurance; oversight of cash and disbursements; management and consolidation of system debt; oversight of an off-shore captive insurance company; financing of new system initiatives; and financial analysis and business planning.

Prior to joining Hartford HealthCare in 2009, Mr. Stys was managing director and principal of Fairmount Capital Advisors Inc. of Philadelphia, a firm providing advice on financial and credit structuring, particularly in health care and education. His other previous positions include associate national director in health care for Tatum LLC in Philadelphia; partner and interim chief financial officer with Acadia Healthcare Company in Alpharetta, Ga.; senior vice president for corporate business affairs with Elwyn Inc. of Elwyn, Penn.; senior vice president of finance and treasurer with Bancroft Neurohealth in Haddonfield, N.J.; chief financial officer with Numoda Corporation in Philadelphia; and senior vice president of investment banking with Commerce Capital Markets Inc. in Philadelphia. He held additional management and executive positions in the financial arena earlier in his career.

Mr. Stys graduated from The Lawrenceville School in New Jersey and obtained his Bachelor of Science in mechanical engineering from Lehigh University in Pennsylvania. He also received his MBA, with a concentration in finance, from Lehigh. Mr. Stys was a licensed certified public accountant and has been licensed through the National Association of Securities Dealers.
