

# CME Department Guidelines for State-Mandated Education for Physician and APRN Relicensure

The State of Connecticut mandated education classes for relicensure for physicians and APRNs include 7 hours of CME covering 6 topics.

- *The following topics are strictly defined as to their minimum content*<sup>1</sup>
  - Infectious Disease MUST address AIDS/HIV as part of the content
  - Risk Management MUST address prescribing controlled substances and pain management as part of the content
  - Behavioral Health MUST include 2 hours of mental health in veterans and families
  
- *The following topics allow education planners significant leeway as to the approach and specific content*
  - Domestic Violence
  - Sexual Assault
  - Cultural Competency

## Reminders

1. The learning objectives of the program MUST reflect the mandated content, or the CME Department will not be able to certify the education as meeting the state mandate
2. The CME Department will make the final determination as to whether or not a class meets the state mandates
3. The state mandate will be noted on the participant's certificate and transcript
